

Returning to Preschool after Covid

If your child has tested positive for Covid:

- Your child must stay home for 5 days, regardless of whether he/she had any symptoms
- The CDC and Health Department recommend that all people wear masks days 6 – 10 following an exposure or positive case of Covid

If your child has been exposed to a positive case of Covid:

- Your child must stay home for 5 days from his/her last day of exposure
- If your child develops symptoms at any point during the 5-day quarantine, he/she must now quarantine for 5 days from the day his/her symptoms first began
- The CDC and Health Department recommend that all people wear masks days 6 – 10 following an exposure or positive case of Covid

If your child has any Covid-like symptoms (*such as runny nose, cough, sore throat, fatigue*):

- **Please keep him home**
- Check with your pediatrician to see if your child should be tested
